

## **STUDENT DRESS EXPECTATIONS**

Students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate for an educational setting. Clothing with offensive words and slogans is not acceptable, nor is it acceptable to wear messages that promote violence, sexism, alcohol, drugs or gang affiliations.

You are reminded that clothing that adversely affects the learning environment of others will be brought to the attention of school administration. Possible course of action includes: contact with parent or guardian, directing students to change clothing, sending students home to change.

It is expected that students will wear clothing that does not reveal under garments.

Headwear and hoodies are to be removed when students enter the school. Outerwear must be stored in lockers.

## **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

All students are encouraged to leave equipment such as cell phones, electronic music players, or hand-held game devices at home. If students decide to bring these devices to school, the items must be locked in the lockers during class times. Students are permitted to retrieve their electronic items from their lockers at lunch time for use outside of the building.

During school dances, students are not permitted to use personal electronic devices such as cell/smart phones and are asked to turn these in at the office upon arrival at the dance.

Staff may confiscate electronic devices from students and turn the items in to the office. Parents or guardians will be contacted if a student is in chronic defiance of this school-wide expectation.
